## Helping Families in Uganda

Uganda has experienced many challenges over the years, leaving thousands hungry and unable to feed their families. Recent flash floods in the Kasese region have significantly affected people's lives. Flooding of riverbanks has led to destruction of crops, roads, schools and health centres, displacing thousands of people.

The Kasese region is located near two major lakes and several rivers, making it prone to flooding. When these rivers overflow, farm land and crops are destroyed.

Acres of land in the villages surrounding Kasese have become unproductive for farming. Together, we can help these families reclaim the land and restore their farms.

## How Can You Help?

ERDO, in partnership with the Pentecostal Assemblies of God Uganda (PAG-U), is working with families to provide different ways to protect against flooding and to access food. ERDO is working with these communities to create long term solutions together to increase the amount of food and nutrition available for families. Working directly with farmers will bring them increased income and help them break free from poverty.

ERDO will be working with 640 farming families, approximately 3,712 people, in four villages. Many families in this area face challenges such as land degradation, irregular rainfall, soil infertility and limited land to grow crops that prevent them from producing enough food to feed themselves or to make an income. Gender inequalities also prevent women from fully participating in agriculture.

This project will protect families from future situations, especially flooding, that make it difficult to grow food. Families will work to protect their farms by reinforcing river banks to divert water away from their fields and establish early warning systems so that they can prepare for any future flooding. It will also work on increasing families' food production through conservation agriculture, which is a farming technique that focuses on protecting land from degradation. This project also aims at empowering women by giving them access to savings and credit services so they are able to meet the financial needs of their families.
