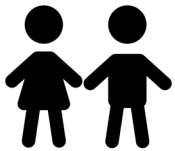

Kenya Food Assistance - matched 4:1

- Providing food assistance to 9,020 beneficiaries with supplementary food

South Sudan Refugee Food Assistance - matched 4:1

- Providing food assistance to 2,000 pregnant and nursing mothers and children under 5 suffering from acute moderate malnutrition and 500 persons with special needs nutritional food supplements

Rohingya Food Assistance - matched 4:1

- Providing food assistance to 182,209 beneficiaries

Katana Conservation Agriculture - matched 1:1

- Increased food security for 300 households (2,100 people) through provision of seeds, tools, and training in Conservation Agriculture

Karamoja Climate Change - matched 1:1

- Increased food security for 300 households (2,000 people) through provision of seeds/tools and training in Conservation Agriculture and marketing strategies

Enhanced Food Security in Somaliland - matched 3:1

- Increased food security for 850 households (2,500 people) in the Sanaag and Sahel regions of Somaliland through agriculture and livelihood projects

Bangladesh Nutrition Supplementary Feeding Program - matched 4:1

- High energy biscuits distributed to 6,800 pre-school children two times daily, six days a week
- Distributed de-worming syrup to children and tablets to teachers and volunteers twice a year
- Monthly learning opportunities in nutrition and hygiene for 3,200 mothers

Zimbabwe In-School Feeding Program - matched 4:1

- Meals provided five times a week to 17,404 registered primary school children, 1,420 pre-school aged children, 300 teachers, and 180 volunteer cooks in Tsholotsho and Esibobvu
- De-worming medicine to 17,404 registered children in Tsholotsho and Esibobvu
